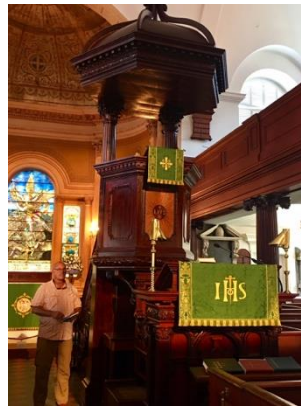

Carolina Day, which marks the
anniversary of the Battle of
Sullivan’s Island on 28 June 1776.
On that day, American forces led by
Major General William Moultrie,
who was a colonel at the time of the
battle, repelled an attempted British
invasion of Charleston. Moultrie
and his men forced the British to
retreat on that day.**

**The Palmetto Society was formed in
1777 to provide relief to widows and
orphans of soldiers killed at the
Battle of Sullivan’s Island as well
as hold an annual remembrance of
the battle and American victory.

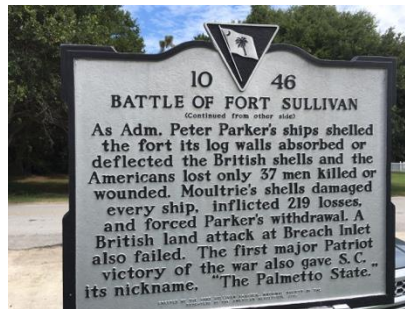
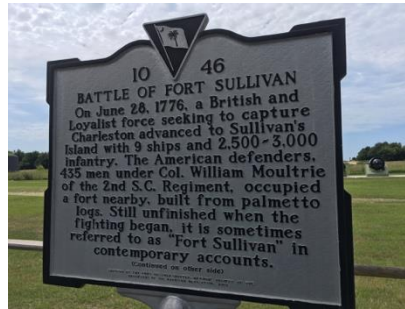
